Proposal for Annual Paving Bid, INQUIRY NO. 1625

Chambers County is taking bids for labor, equipment, and any incidentals required to complete the work of the following items required for the annual paving needs of the County. This bid is intended to comply with Alabama Code Title 39, the Alabama Public Works Law. Bidders shall be required to comply with the provisions of Title 39 of the Alabama Code regardless if the requirement is explicitly detailed in the bid proposal or not. This bid shall be in effect from June 1st 2018 until December 31st 2018 covering any Proceed Orders issued by Chambers County during that time frame.

This bid is intended for 100% County funded projects, only. The contractor shall meet all Alabama Department of Transportation Bonding and Licensing requirements. All bid items shall be placed in accordance with the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications unless approved by the Chambers County Engineer. All materials shall meet current ALDOT specifications with the following exception, unless otherwise approved by the Chambers County Engineer: No recycled asphalt shingles (RAS) will be allowed in any plant mix item. Upon Request, Test Reports shall be submitted on all materials before Payment will be made. The contractor shall furnish flagmen and portable traffic control devices (or other method approved by the County Engineer) in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The Chambers County Engineer shall serve as final authority for all phases of workmanship and materials.

The contractor shall give Chambers County at least 48 hours' notice in advance of performing work at any site once a Proceed Order has been issued by Chambers County. The Contractor must receive written permission to work on Saturdays, Sundays, or County holidays 48 hours prior to such work commencing. Unless otherwise directed in writing by the County Engineer, the Contractor will be expected to begin work within 15 calendar days after issuance of the Proceed Order. The Contractor will be given a minimum of 30 Working Days, as defined in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, per Proceed Order. Each proceed order shall designate the amount of working days allowed. Should the Contractor fail to complete the proceed order within the working days stipulated, liquidated damages shall be assessed as defined in section 108.10 in the current revision of the Alabama Department of Transportation Standard Specifications.

If you are unable to furnish an item as specified and desire to offer a substitute, please give full description of the items offered as substitutes, otherwise your quotations will not be considered. If no exception is made on bid sheet, it will be assumed that the bidder is offering the articles specified.

The unit prices below will apply to each Proceed Order issued. A Proceed Order may include multiple projects or sites. Each proceed order shall note the items required and estimated quantities per project or site.

Certified check or bid bond for \$10,000 made payable to the Chambers County Commission must accompany each bid as evidence of good faith. Within 15 days of bid award, a Performance Bond for \$1,000,000 and a Payment Bond for \$500,000 (each attached) shall be submitted to Chambers County along with the contract documents (attached) and proof of general and liability insurance.

A Job Mix Design must be submitted, by the Contractor, to Chambers County following the receipt of a Proceed Order. PRICE ADJUSTMENTS will be made to all Asphalt Materials in accordance with the following: It is understood and agreed that the price per ton of materials bid is based on prices at the time of opening of bids. Prices on contracts developed from this bid will be adjusted based on the PRICE INDEX per gallon of asphalt as determined by the ALDOT Asphalt Index for the month of APRIL 2018. Any increase or decrease in asphalt prices will be determined and adjusted by the price index for the month in which delivery and placement is made. Adjustment will be made in accordance with the current ALDOT Specifications. This adjustment shall apply to the amount of tack and prime used and the amount of liquid used in the plant mix material.

The successful bidder shall also be required to meet all post construction advertising requirements under Alabama Code Title 39. Notice of completion shall be given for each proceed order by advertising four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published within Chambers County.

Upon completion and acceptance of all work required, per Proceed Order, the contractor will be paid upon presentation of the following:

- a. A properly executed and duly certified voucher for payment.
- b. A release of all claims and claims of liens against the awarding authority arising by virtue of the contract.
- c. Proof of advertisement of project completion.

Payment will be made within 35 days after all of the above requirements are met. **Partial Payment for proceed orders will be provided under this contract. Retainage shall be withheld on each Proceed Order as provided under Code of Alabama Section 39-2-12.**

By submitting this proposal the contracting parties affirm, for the duration of the agreement, that they will not violate the federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a contracting party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom.

Signature on bid must be in ink. Bids made out in pencil will NOT be accepted. Bid must be NOTARIZED. County reserves the right to accept or reject all Bids or any portion thereof.
